Introduction: About the College

Virginia Peninsula Community College, one of 23 colleges within the Virginia Community College System (VCCS), is a comprehensive, public, two-year community college. The College enrolled its first 1,232 students in Fall 1968 at its Hampton Campus. In 2003, the College officially established the Historic Triangle Campus to serve students in the Greater Williamsburg area.

Virginia Peninsula's current mission statement is as follows: We change lives and transform our community through diverse, inclusive, and equitable education and workforce training, excellent support and services, and innovative partnerships. The College serves the Virginia Peninsula, encompassing the cities of Hampton, Newport News, Poquoson, and Williamsburg, and the counties of James City and York, in southeast Virginia. Virginia Peninsula is an open enrollment institution; students are eligible for admission to Virginia Peninsula if they are high school graduates or the equivalent, or if they are 18 years of age or older and able to benefit academically from study at the College, as demonstrated by assessment in reading, writing, and mathematics.

In Academic Year 2021-2022, Virginia Peninsula served 8,987 students (unduplicated headcount) in credit instruction, making it the sixth largest college within the Virginia Community College System in terms of headcount. The College serves a highly diverse region, and its student body closely reflects the demographics of the greater community. Of the College's 8,987 credit students, 60.1% are female and 68.1% are under the age of 25. By race/ethnicity, 45.5% of students are White, 28.0% are Black or African American, 9.8% are Hispanic, and the remaining 16.7% identify as another race or as two or more races, or did not specify their race/ethnicity.

Traditionally underserved populations, as defined by student race/ethnicity, first-generation status, and Pell Grant receipt, comprise 60.7% of the College's unduplicated credit headcount.

Additionally, the College's students have a variety of educational goals. Of its 8,987 credit students in 2021-2022, 38.7% were enrolled in transfer degree programs; 29.8% were enrolled in applied degree programs, certificate programs, or career studies certificate programs; and 31.5% were non-curricular. Virginia Peninsula serves a region that is home to many military service members and their families. In Academic Year 2021-2022, 25.3% of Virginia Peninsula credit students indicated a military affiliation (e.g., active-duty, veteran, military spouse, or military dependent).

The College is committed to best serving its students and community, and is engaged in a five year strategic plan, titled *Thrive 2027*, that is designed to advance the institution in the areas of diversity, equity, and inclusion, instructional innovation, powerful partnerships, modernized marketing and recruitment, employee investment and development, and transparent and authentic communication.

Definitions

Asynchronous class: A class that lacks defined starting and ending times, such as independent studies or internships.

Day class: A class that begins before 6:00pm.

Distance class: A class that is taught entirely online.

Evening class: A class that begins at 6:00pm or later.

Full-time Equivalent Students (FTES): The sum of annual enrolled credit hours divided by 30.

Full-time faculty: A teaching faculty member that has a nine- or twelve-month contract; categorization comes from IPEDS HR data.

Hampton student: A student who enrolled in one or more classes that met on the Hampton campus.

Historic Triangle student: A student who enrolled in one or more classes that met on the Historic Triangle campus.

Hybrid class: A class with both distance and face-to-face components.

Part-time faculty: A faculty member without a full-time teaching contract; categorization comes from Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) Human Resources data.

Traditional class: A class that meets entirely face-to-face.
