In reply to your letter of the 14th, I am very glad to be able to add quite a bit to the little information you say you have on Dr. Corbin Griffin.

In explanation of the attached xerox copy of a card from our files relative to Dr. Griffin, the references in type under the heading <u>Children</u> which have a five or six digit number before the name refer to the membership number of descendants who are members of this Society, and whose eligibility for joining is based on Dr. Griffin's service in the American Revolutionary War.

On the upper right hand corner is a condensed record of Dr. Griffin's service. The sources, etc., are given on the reverse side of the card, and it is these that will be of particular, and important, interest to you. And all are, no doubt, easily available to you. Heitman is, of course, Francis B. Heitman's Historical Register of Officers of the Continental Army during the War of the Revolution. The other references are more explicit.

It has been a pleasure to be of help to you in this matter.
